he excuses men give for sins are: 'I did not know'; 'Someone made me do it'; 'It did not feel like a bad thing'; or even, 'I am not the only one doing it'.

All these excuses are ways we justify our actions, and suppress the guilt we feel for doing them.

Most times we would like someone else to bear the blames for our wrong actions. The truth is that even if we succeed in blaming others for our own wrong doings, or shift the blame to someone else, the guilt cannot be shifted. The guilt remain and we are hunted by the guilt of our wrong doings, and that makes us not entirely free, because we bear the guilt of our sins. So, we are all in search of freedom.

SHIFTING BLAMES

Someone else should bear the blame

Shifting blames, and giving excuses for wrong doings, happened from the creation of man – from Adam and Eve our first parent.

We read in Genesis what happened to the instruction God gave to man.

Genesis 2 verse 16 to 17, the Scripture said, "And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, 'Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die"

Reading down, we saw that man did eat of that tree, which the LORD God commanded him not to eat. Now when God asked the man why he ate the fruit of that tree which He commanded him not to eat, he pointed his finger at his wife Eve, and said, "*The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree and I ate*". Then God turned to the

woman and said, "What is this you have done?" .. The woman also pointed

her finger at the serpent and said, "The

serpent deceived me, and I ate" (Gen.

3:12-13)

There were shifting of blames, everyone not owning up to their responsibility of committing the act of disobedient.



We all will love someone else to bear our blame, take the punishment on our behalf

The consequence of that disobedient made them to be naked and exposed, such that they gathered fig leaves to cover themselves because they were ashamed of their nakedness.

So when God arrived the garden they hid themselves from Him, then God called out for them saying, "*Adam, where are you*?" (V.9). Adam answered from his hiding place and said, "*I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself*" (V.10)

Guilt made them afraid, and hid themselves from God's presence.

GOD'S MERCIES

Mercy is God's nature

But God in His mercies and love for the man He created in His image and likeness; permitted that their blame be shifted to an animal, because the Scripture said "Also for Adam and his wife the LORD God made tunics of skin, and clothed them" (V.21). Though it is not recorded which animal died that day, for Adam and his wife Eve, to be covered from the nakedness of their wrong doings.

GOD'S DEALINGS, WITH THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL The Love Stories Between God and Man

Fast forward to the times of the Jews – the descendant of Jacob, Isaac, and Abraham. Because, God made a promise to Abraham saying, "And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you" (Gen. 17:7). This covenant God kept with the descendants of Abraham, who are called the children of Israel and also the Jews.

Now to these Jews, whom the LORD God chose to be their God, He gave them commandments to obey – ranging from the Ten Commandment and other ceremonial laws, which they must obey as their obligations to the covenant relationship they have with Him.

GOD'S LOVING PROVISIONS

But aside from giving them the commandment, God in His

loving kindness, made provision for them to pass on their blames – God specifically told them to pick out an animal without blemish as a sin offering.

In Leviticus 4, let us read through the ordinances and God instructions to Moses for the children of Israel:

"Now the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, 'Speak to the children of Israel, saying, 'If a person sins unintentionally against any commandments of the LORD in anything which ought not to be done, and does any of them; [First] if the anointed priest sins, bringing guilt on the people, then let him offer to the LORD for his sin which he has sinned a young bull without blemish as a sin offering. He shall bring the bull to the door of the tabernacle of meeting before the LORD, lay his hand on the bull's head and kill the bull before the LORD" (Leviticus 4:1-4);

"Now if the whole congregation of Israel sins unintentionally, and the thing is hidden from the eyes of the assembly, and they have done something against any of the commandments of the LORD in anything which should not be done, and are guilty; when the sin which they have committed becomes known, then the assembly shall offer a young bull for the sin, and bring it before the tabernacle of meeting. And the elders of the congregation shall lay their hands on the head of the bull before the LORD. Then the bull shall be killed before the LORD." (V.13-15);

"When a ruler has sinned, and done something unintentionally against any of the commandments of the LORD his God in anything which should not be done, and is guilty, or if his sin which he has committed comes to his knowledge, he shall bring as his offering a kid of the goats, a male without blemish. And he shall lay his hand on the head of the goat, and kill it at the place where they kill the burnt offering before the LORD. It is a sin offering." (V.22-24)

(If anyone sins unintentionally — if his sin which he has committed comes to his knowledge) This is saying, anytime they are aware and admit that they did something wrong, then they are to offer a sacrifice for the wrong.

"If anyone of the common people sin unintentionally by doing something against any of the commandments of the LORD in anything which ought not to be done, and is guilty, or if his sin which he has committed comes to his knowledge, then he shall bring as his offering a kid of the goats, a female without blemish, for his sin which he has committed. And he shall lay his hand on the head of the sin offering, and kill the sin offering at the place of the burnt

offering." (V.27-29)

NOTE: The animals which are offered for the sin committed, did no sin, but God allowed that the animal should take the blame and be the scape goat for man's sins. The one who sin unintentionally offers this animals, and it must be an animal without blemishes; when his sin has come to his knowledge. Also in the mercies of God, no one is exempted here, from the priest to the elders, to the whole



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congregation, and the common people in their mist; the provision covers all.



THE SIGNIFICANCE OF ALL THESE TO US IN THIS AGE

Now in the New Testament, Apostle Paul noted that even though God permitted them to pass on their blames to the animals, this practices which they had to do from time to time, did not totally purge their conscience from the guilt of the sins, they have committed. He explains that these rituals were symbolic for the present time and the laws were just a shadow of the good things to come –

Hebrews 9:9-10 says, "It was symbolic for the present time in which both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make him who performed the service perfect in regard to conscience – concerned only with foods and drinks, various washings, and fleshly ordinances imposed until the time of reformation."

CHRIST THE VERY IMAGE OF THE GOOD THING

So because these symbolic rituals were only imposed, to wait for the time of reformation; he further explains thus:

"But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption" (V.11-12)

"For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect. --- For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins.

Therefore, when (Jesus) came into the world, He said, '*Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, but a body You have prepared for Me. In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure. Then I said, 'Behold, I have come – in the volume of the book it is written of Me – to do Your will, o God.*''' (Heb. 10:1,4,5,6,7) These explanations gave us the understanding that those sacrifices God permitted the Jews to carry out were a symbol for the present time, and also a shadow of the good things to come. Though those sacrifices were imposed to be carried out until the time of reformation, they were not able to completely purge the consciences of those who committed the sins.

CHRIST THE PERFECT AND SPOTLESS LAMB OF GOD

Therefore when Jesus Christ came into the world, Him being the very image of the good thing which has come, said, "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, but a body You have prepared for Me. Then I said, 'Behold, I have come to do Your will O God"

Jesus declared that God does not desire the sacrifices of goats and bulls, and that He had prepared for Him a body, to come and do His will.

Jesus Christ came to do the will of Almighty God. And that will was to carry on His body the blame of man; to be the scape goat for man's sin; to be that perfect without blemish and spot Lamb of God for the sacrifice of the sins of man. The perfect sacrifice that can purge both the sin and the guilt of man.

Apostle Paul wrote, "For if the blood of bulls and goats and

the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?" (Heb. 9:13-14)

No wonder when John the Baptist saw Him, he said, "Behold! The Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:29)

In Romans 3:25 Apostle Paul wrote that this Jesus is the one, "Whom God set forth as a propitiation (The appeaser) by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed"

Apostle John also wrote, "And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world". And then he later added, "In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation (Appeaser) for our sins. " (1John 2:2, 4:10)

God in His love and mercies sent Jesus and made a body for Him, to be used for the sacrifice offered for sins.

Just as God permitted the Jews to place their hands on the head of an animal without blemish, who committed no sin, and to pass on their blame on the animal and kill it on the

place of the burnt offerings, so was Jesus given by God as the perfect without blemish sin offering for us to pass on our blames.

The Scripture said, "For God made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him" (2Cor. 5:21)



WE HAVE THE SAME PRIVILEGE TODAY

oday I and you have the same privilege like the children of Israel, to pass on our blames.

Remember the instructions was, "If anyone of the common people sin unintentionally by doing something against any of the commandments of the LORD in anything which ought not to be done, and is guilty, or if his sin which he has committed comes to his knowledge, then he shall bring as his offering a kid of the goats, a female without blemish, for his sin which he has committed. And he shall lay his hand on the head of the sin offering, and kill the sin offering at the place of the burnt offering"

Since Jesus Christ has been given to replace the goats, we who have done something which ought not to be done, and our sins have come to our knowledge, and we admit that what we have done is wrong, though we did not do them intentionally, we did them ignorantly, and it is against the commandment of our God; and we are sorry for the wrong – this provision has been made by God that we can come to the throne of mercy, surrender the sin to Jesus, and ask Him to forgive us and to cleanse us with His blood.

The fact that the Scripture said, "*He is the propitiation for the whole world*"; meaning everybody has the privilege of this provision. Whoever you are, as long as you are living in this world, Jesus has been given by God to be the appeaser, or the go-in-between, for your sins; so you have no excuse for your sins. Jesus Himself said to the Jews who rejected Him, "*If I had not come and spoken to you, you would have no sin, but now you have no excuse for your sin* (John 15:22)

PAUSE AND ACT

Where are you right now? Are you still here? What is going on in your head right now? What are you thinking? Are there any sins you are still bearing the guilt? Are there sins in your life that you have thought, "God will never forgive me for these ones?

THERE IS NO ALTANATIVE

Right now there is no other sacrifice; God Himself abolished the sacrifice of animals for sin offerings; but made provision for everyone. I don't know what excuse you will give to God, for holding on to your sins and refusing to surrender them to the Lord Jesus, who was sent by God to bear the sin of the world, after reading this article.

This is like Jesus coming to say, "If I had not tell you, you would have no sin, but now you have no excuse for your sins"

Now that you have heard, it is your choice now to either believe and take action or disbelieve and ignore.

But if you believe and you want to take action, here is what to do:

PRAY THIS PRAYER:

Dear heavenly Father and Creator, thank You for Your tender mercies and love. Though I do not merit it in any way, but I believe Your word – thank You for the gift of Your Son Jesus, to bear the blame of all my sins. Right now dear Lord Jesus, I confess that I am a sinner, who does not deserve any pardon, but because, I have read that You came so that you will bear my sins, I ask that You forgive me all my sins – the ones I know and the ones I do not know, I surrender all to You today to purge me and cleanse me from all of them. I believe in the forgiveness You purchased with Your blood, and I receive the forgiveness today in Jesus name. Amen.

If you have prayed this prayer with your whole heart, believe that God has forgiven you through the sacrifice of Jesus.

Believe in God's faithfulness to His promise which He said, "For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more" (Heb. 8:12)

Believe also in this assuring words of Jesus, "He who believes in Him is not condemned" (John 3:18)

And then believe this one that God Himself said, "I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters" (2Cor. 6:18)

Lastly, believe you are saved!

THE NEW KINGDOM A Kingdom which God is King

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The New Kingdom

loved it, when I looked up Merriam-Webster dictionary for the word, "Kingdom" and it says, "*The spiritual world of which God is King*".

This definition says it all; The new kingdom we will be discussing here, is a world of which God is king and no other, and it is a spiritual world meaning it is not physical but those who believe, can see it only by faith.



INTRODUCING THE NEW KINGDOM

esus began His earthly ministry as recorded in Matt 4:17, by saying, "*Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand*" Also, the gospel according to mark records, "*Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, and saying,*" *The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel*" (Mark 1:14-5).

This was the introduction of that new kingdom.

Jesus introduces the new kingdom and His gospel was the gospel of a kingdom; the new kingdom which God who is king in it, is bringing to men.

Jesus came to announce the new kingdom God had sent Him to bring to man. The good news of a kingdom, different from the one, man has been living in and used to - was the message of Christ.

This kingdom as defined, is "The spiritual world of which God is king"; Jesus brought this message, and according to Him, He invites everyone to Repent (which means, change your mind_; and believe in the gospel, so that you can come in.



HOW TO ENTER THE NEW KINGDOM

he only way Jesus said anyone can enter the new kingdom, is first, change your mind. Second, believe. In John 3:16; Jesus said to Nicodemus "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send HIs Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved, He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already because he has not believe in

the name of the only begotten Son of God" (John 3:16-18).

This scripture tells us what God did, what He expect of us, and what the end result is.

in John 1:29, It is written,

"Behold: The lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world" Also in 2nd Corinthians chapter 5 verse 21, it is written, "For God made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him", Then Hebrew chapter 9 verse 28 says, "So Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many".

All these scriptures talks about what God did through His Son Jesus Christ. Now, what is expected of man - man's obligation in all of this is, for man to change his mind from disbelieving God, and accept without doubt that God had indeed done this and then believe salvation as a gift, even though man does not merit it, so that he can receive it.

When man accept and believe this act of kindness and love

from God, the resultant effect is, salvation for the soul of that man.

Salvation, does not require any other work from man, than Believe. Salvation is the work of God that man needs to believe and accept.

Ephesians chapter 2 verse 8 to 9 said, "For by grace you have been saved through (believing), and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boasts".

Here we can see that, God gave the gift, man accept and believe the gift, and the result is, "Salvation". There is no work done by man here, but just believing what God had done.



TAKE A BOLD STEP

If you are reading this story and you have any doubt about the salvation of your soul, cease this opportunity and get it

right. It does not take anything other than you accepting what God did and

believing it with your whole heart, then confessing with your mouth, to be saved.

Romans chapter 10 verse 9 to 10 says, "*That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.*"

If you have accepted this truth, and you have believed it with your heart, and you have made confession with your mouth, congratulation, you're saved!



Welcome to the new Kingdom. Going back to the definition of the new

kingdom, which is described as, "The Spiritual World which God is King".

Once you are saved or once you have received salvation by believing in

your heart, there is a corresponding action in the spirit realm.

In the spirit realm you are spiritually moved from the previous kingdom where you were into the new kingdom that Jesus promised. In the spirit realm your location automatically change, and you are no more in the old kingdom. Even though you may not feel anything or see any changes, there is a movement in the spirit realm that changes your overall location and state.

Colossians chapter 1 verse 13 says, "He has delivered us from the power

of darkness and conveyed us (which signifies movement) into the kingdom

of the Son of His love". This is what

happened in the spirit realm

immediately you receive salvation.

NEW CREATIONS

Apostle Paul wrote saying, "Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation, old things have In the spirit realm your location automatically change, and you are no more in the old kingdom. passed away, behold, all things have become new". (2 Corinthians 5: 17).

Everyone that is conveyed into the kingdom of Christ has become a new creation in the new kingdom. The old person that was in the flesh and in the kingdom of darkness died,

and everything that he did and that was over him, died also.

And in this state, God made a promise and said, "For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and lawless deeds I will remembered no more" (Hebrews 8: 12).

So this new born child of God in the kingdom of Christ is a complete new creation.

This is the message Jesus was relating to Nicodemus, a Pharisee, who came to Him by night; when He said to him, "*Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God"* (John 3: 3).



NEW DESTINATION AND NEW STATE



eing born again in a new Kingdom of which God is the king, means every condition or bondage of the old kingdom, which is the kingdom of darkness, ceased to exist in that person's life.

So, it will be wrong for that person to pray prayers like: God change my destiny, or

Some prayers like:-

Prayer of breaking of family yoke

Breaking of bondage.

These prayers are not just totally wrong, but are Satan's tricks to make a child of God who have confessed that he or she is saved through the sacrifice that Jesus did on the cross, to negate his or her confession and doubt his or hers salvation, and be once again entangled in the bondage of Satan.

When you have receive salvation, there is no destiny of bad or good hanging above your head, there is no family or familiar bondage keeping you in chain, you died in the flesh and so did all these conditions, and every written destiny. Jesus did not come to change your destiny, nor does He change destinies; He came that He might convey us into the new kingdom where God is King.

So Jesus offers not a destiny change, but a destination change – and you do not need a destiny change, if your destination has change.

33.

Everyone who is saved, does not need, destiny change, deliverance, or braking curses, or of familiar yoke.

Salvation was a complete package of rescue for man from God.

Salvation is defined as

(a) Deliverance from the power and effect of sin;

(b) Liberation from ignorance or illusion;

© Preservation from destruction or failure;

(d) Deliverance from danger or difficulty.

This definition does not leave room for any other acts of rescuing man.

What God sent His Son Jesus to accomplish on the cross, was the final rescue for both the physical and the spiritual man.

Anything outside of this is unbelief, that leads to condemnation according to John 3:17-18.



THE NEW WALK

Now you are born anew in a new kingdom, which is the kingdom of Christ,

and you are spiritually a child of God in Christ.

Note, as a new born, in a new territory, everything in this new territory is new to you. You will need to learn the new ways of thinking, walking, and talking in this new kingdom. That is why Apostle Peter wrote, "As new born babes, desire the pure milk of the word that you may grow thereby" (1Peter 2:2).

Just like every new born child needs milk to grow, in this new kingdom, the word of God, is the pure milk that will

help you to grow; so just as Apostle Peter said, desire it; read it always;

search it, as if one is searching for gold. Do not wait for someone to tell you what the Bible says, read it yourself.

If you are asking, "where do I start?" My advice is begin with the New Testament.

Read the gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. These all records the story of the salvation that Jesus did and taught; then read about the Apostles, their acts and their letters to those who have believed their story; read the book of revelation to understand how it will all end and the hope you have as a believer. Read the Old Testament to see how God was faithful to His promises with those who believed Him in the past, also to see what happened to those who rejected God.

THE JOURNEY IS IN STAGES

All of these is to help you in your journey; but remember, the journey you embarking on is in stages. You are born anew in a new kingdom, just Like a new born baby will fall while attempting to sit for the first time, or while attempting to crawl for the first time, or while attempting to take his first step; you will experience all these stages, but do not loose heart or give up in whatever stage you are.

If you should fall, don't remain fallen, stand up, pick yourself up and continue walking.

Apostle John wrote, "*If we confess our sins, His is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness --- My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous*"

(1John 1: 1-9; 2: 1).

That is why you do not need to remain flat on your face, or remain fallen. God has made every provision for you to succeed. He is not against you, He is for you, and with you. Because you have become His beloved He does not hate you when you fail, He is more interested in you giving it your best to do right things; He does not keep records of your wrongs to punish you, but urges you in the spirit to receive the forgiveness the blood of Jesus provides. God indeed is for you and nothing can be against you.



PROVISION FOR THE JOURNEY

Now because God loves you and He want you to overcome every obstacle on your way and succeed, He has made these provisions for you in your walk in this new kingdom:

(1) The blood of Jesus has purchased a down payment for

forgiveness, in case you need it along the way, just as Apostle John said in

1st John 1: 9.

(2) **The word** of God has been provided as a spiritual milk for you to drink and grow, (Heb.5:13); and also as a lamp to your feet, to show you where to drop your feet (Ps 119:105); Then as a purifier and sanctifier to renew your heart daily (John 17:17; Eph.5:26).

(3) **The Helper,** who is the Spirit of God, has been sent to you, to teach you, guide you, comfort you, and bear testimony with your spirit and about you, that you are a child of God. (John 14:26, 16:13 Rom.8:16, 1John 5:8); Then to seal you, and preserve you, until the day of redemption of the saints (Eph. 1:13,4:30.

All these is what you have and who you are in the new kingdom of Christ.

Remember all these is happening in the spirit realm, and in the kingdom of Christ that you now belong.

Also to remember, is that you entered the kingdom by believing what God did through Christ for you; and you will remain in the kingdom by also still believing what God did, and what He promise to keep doing in your life.

This is Apostle Paul's admonishment to believers, "*This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk* (those who have no knowledge of God), *in the futility of their mind, having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart;* –(But) *be renewed in the spirit of your mind*"

Don't share in the ignorance of those who have rejected the truth written in the word of God, but be renewed in the spirit of your mind. In this kingdom we live by believing and believing alone.


