SUNDAY DECEMBER 1 LAWS - TO SAVE OR TO ENSLAVE?

Laws generally is a means of redressing wrongs and maintaining order in a community,so was God's laws to the children of Israel, His chosen people. God gave them the laws when they were about entering the promise land, as a means of redressing wrongs, so that they will live in harmony with each other.

It was not meant to enslave them, but to give them freedom and peace.

Man on the other hand turns the law of God and even misinterpret it, in attempt to use the law as a weapon to enslave.

Jesus said,

"They bind heavy burdens, hard to bear, and lay them on men's shoulder" (Matt.23:4).

But Jesus came that He might set us free from the bondage of men's laws, and give us liberty to serve the living God willingly. As it stands, God did not abolish His laws, but instead He said,

"I will put My laws in their minds and write it on their hearts" Also, "I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them" (Jer.31:33, Eze.36:27).

God's Spirit had been sent, to everyone who believe and accept Jesus as Lord and Savior; in other that He may teach, guide, and help them to walk in the ways of God – it is no longer by men's interpretation of God's law that we are to serve God, but by the leading of His Spirit in us.

Believing in Jesus gives you liberty to love the Lord with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.

So instead of binding yourselves with laws and regulations of men in order to serve God, summit and receive the teachings and guidance of the Holy Spirit, so that you can serve God willingly in love.

THINK IT OUT

Are you loving and serving God willingly with the liberty that Christ sacrifice provides, or are you being compelled by the law to serve God?

OVERCOMING BY FAITH

Faith is having an absolute trust in God and in His word.

Apostle Paul defined faith as the substance of things hoped for, [and] the evidence of things not seen (Heb.1:1). We can say, God's word is the substance of our hope and also the evidence of things though not clear to the ordinary eyes, but we have it.

Paul also said, it is by faith that we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God (Heb.11:3).

So also everything that God has made available for us, we understand them or obtain them by faith.

Meaning, we obtain them by believing and trusting God's word.

By believing John 3:16, we receive the

salvation that Jesus died to give us.

By believing John 14:16&23, we also receive the Holy Spirit whom God sent to be with us forever.

To receive forgiveness for our sins, we also need to believe 1John 1:9.

Therefore faith is not an assumption or a trial and error – It is not, 'Let try and see if it works or let just assume it might work.
Faith is not a risky leap into the void.
It is actually an exercise of confidence in God's word.

So the faith that overcomes, is the faith that

has a substance [The Word of God]. That is why it comes by the hearing, and hearing by the Word of God (Rom.10:17).

Ultimately when we hear, receive and trust the word of God, we have a faith that overcomes – and this overcoming faith works in all circumstances, because it is the written word of God.

Our text today says,

"The Israelite pass through the Red Sea as by dry land, [but] the Egyptians attempting [by assumption] to do so, were drowned. Therefore make the Word of God the substance of your faith and the evidence of what you have received from God.

THINK IT OUT

Do you know that assumptions or boldness are no substance to base your faith on? And do you know the only sure substance of an overcoming faith is the written word of God which has the authority and power to be true always?

PRAYER:

Thank You dear Lord for Your Word is true and will remain true at all times. I believe and trust Your Word as my warrantee for all that I hope for and I receive Your Word as the evidence of the hope.

REDEEMED FROM SIN

Jesus Christ died on the cross and poured His blood for the sins of man.

Through His sacrifice, He redeemed us from the bondage of sin and from the kingdom of darkness that took us captive by the permission of sin.

Now we have been translated into the kingdom of light and given the right of sons and daughters with God the Father. All these was done freely, not because of what we did, but because of Jesus' sacrifice as recorded in Ephesians 2:8-9.

When we accepted and believed the salvation massage, we became the righteous children of God because of Him.

The question Apostle Paul asked is, after becoming the righteous children of God, should we continue to live in sin? It is obvious that we all know the answer to this question, which is, of course "No". We are called to walk as children of light, because we now belong to the kingdom of light.

In this kingdom, Jesus said, it is important that we do unto others, what we will want others to do unto us (Matt.7:12) He said that, 'we are the light of the world', so we are to shine for others to see this light and be able to follow.

We are also called the salt of the earth, it therefore means that our actions and words are to be seasoned, and it should have taste. All these we cannot achieve on our own without His divine help; thank God, He had sent the Holy Spirit to us, to help us in this walk with Christ.

Jesus already said, the Holy Spirit will teach us all things, He will guide us into all truth, and He will be with us forever (John 14:16,26, 16:13)

So for you not to continue in sin, ask the Holy Spirit to help you, and be ready to cooperate with Him as He teaches you all things, guides you into all truth and help you to walk in them.

THINK IT OUT

Do you know redemption gives you power

and right to overcome sins through the help of the Holy Spirit?

so our companionship with the Holy Spirit will make the journey, less effort, more trusting which will equal best result.

FEAR AND LOVE

The story of Ananias and Sapphira his wife, who sold their goods, kept part of the proceeds of the sales to themselves and lied to Apostle Peter, is not new, but has the lesson of the story been understood by today's believers?

It is recorded that the news of their death brought great fear to the church and to all who heard it (V.11).

Is that fear still observable today among believers?

Why do we sing love songs and praises to God with our lips, but disregard the lessons His word teaches us?

Proverb 14:27 says,

"The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, to turn one away from the snares of death" Love and fear is what we accord to God. To 'fear' the Lord God, is to have a feeling of respect and wonder for the creator of the universe.

If we say, we love Him, but not fear Him – we will not keep His word.

But if we fear Him; out of respect for His person and authority, we will walk in His ways and keep His statutes.

Also, because He loved us first, and sent His only begotten Son Jesus to die for our sins, and redeem us, we are compel to love Him also (1John 4:19),

and out of this love, we serve Him with all our heart and with all our soul – rather than merely out of duty.

Apostle John wrote,

"In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him."

Then he said,

"In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins." (1John 4:9,10)

Therefore, our fear and love for Him will enable us walk willingly in obedience to His word.

Reverential fear was lacking in Ananias and Sapphira's love for God, don't let reverential fear be missing in your love for God.

THINK IT OUT

Do you have reverential fear for God? And are you serving Him out of gratitude for His love for you?

PRAYER:

Lord thank You that though You are so great in heaven yet You stoop down to love me. Please help me to love You with reverential fear that brings You honor. Amen

The name "JESUS" was given to man as a

gift from God Almighty.

The angel that announced it told Joseph saying,

"She will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS [Then the mission of the name],

'For He will save His people from their sins'" (Matt.1:21).

Therefore, the name and the mission are tied together as one thus: "JESUS SAVES" There is no other name under heaven that is attached with that mission.

More so, the gospel according to John told us that, "In the beginning', He was called 'THE WORD',

He was with God in the beginning and He was God; all things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made" (John 1:1-3).

Also, in 1John 5:7, He is seated in heaven bearing witness, and His name is, "THE WORD".

Then Revelation 19:13 gives us a glimpse of Him in heaven, clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called, "THE WORD OF GOD"

Clearly, the name, "JESUS" was given to man on earth, to use.

We are given that name "JESUS" to sign whatever request we make to God the Father. Jesus said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name, He will give you. --- Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full" (John 16:23-24).

Also, the name was given so that when you mention it, 'everything will [put their knee on the ground and surrender], things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth' (Phil.2:10).

Hold-on! Before you rush to ask and sign your request with "JESUS", remember the Scripture says, it is only those who have received Him as Lord and Savior of their lives, are given the right of sons to use the name (John 1:12).

And that is because you cannot call on whom you do not believe (Rom.10:13-14).

THINK IT OUT

Have you received Him as LORD? Do you know you cannot call on this name and receive anything if you do not truly believe and trust in Him? And do you know there is no other name given?

SUNDAY DECEMBER 8 REFLECTING CHRIST

Growing in Christ and reflecting His image comes from a deepening relationship with Him. Just like in any relationship, time and communication are key factors to a successful relationship; our relationship with Christ requires, we spend time with Him and communicate always not leaving room for lapses.

You may wonder, 'How do I spend time with Him?' or 'How do I communicate with Him?'

look at you and perceive in their heart, 'This must be an angel!' because you will reflect Christ for spending time with Him.

THINK IT OUT

Do you know spending more time with Jesus will make you Christ like? And if you do not spend time with Him, how else will you get to know Him?

PRAYER:

Dear Father, thank You for creating me in Your image and likeness. Please work in me as I spend time with You, to look like You and reflect You.

MONDAY DECEMBER 9 SEEKING FOR GLORY AND HONOR

As believers in Christ, we need to remind ourselves often that the life we have, for believing in Jesus as the only begotten Son of God and as the Savior of our soul is, "Eternal life" (John 3:16).

Jesus said, "And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand" (John 10:28) And that life in us is Christ living inside of us – which is our hope of glory.

Now therefore because of this hope of glory which will be revealed in us, we continue in patience, doing what is good and acceptable in His sight.

We know that Jesus died to set us free from the condemnation of sins; by taking the condemnation upon Himself and shedding His blood to sanctify us (Heb.13:12); justify us (Rom.3:24) and declare us righteous in the sight of God, making us acceptable in the beloved through faith (Eph.1:6).

We, therefore are no longer debtors or slaves of sins. As it is written,

"Therefore, brethren, we are debtors – [But] not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh --- [Because] having been set free from sin, [we] became slaves of righteousness --- for when we were slaves of sin, we were free in regard to righteousness" (Rom.8:12, 6:18,20)

Now in patience we wait, and continue in doing good, even though it is hard, painful or even full of shame, because we are awaiting this glory and this honor which He will give

to us when He appears.

In these, is our hope.

THINK IT OUT

Do you know this glory and honor will outweigh any pain or shame we've ever endured for His name sake?

PRAYER:

Thank You dear Lord Jesus for Your death that gave us eternal life and that life is our hope of glory. Give us the grace to continue patiently to do good as we seek Your glory and glory alone.

TUESDAY DECEMBER 10 WISDOM THROUGH THE SPIRIT

We all desire wisdom; we will all love to be wise.

But the wisdom of the world is different from

the wisdom that comes from the Spirit of God.

The wisdom of the world is gained by having many experiences in life or by just being naturally smart, able to understand things that must others can't.

When it comes to the wisdom of the Spirit of God, Apostle Paul wrote, "The Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God" (1Cor.2:10).

The Spirit of God searches and knows the mind of God, He then reveals them to us, so that we can better understand what God expect us to do at any given time. The good thing about this wisdom that comes from the Spirit of God are: no special talent is required; even a fool [by men standard] can be wise in the spirit; there is no age limit; no gender discrimination; it comes from the all-knowing, the all-wise God and it is given liberally upon request.

James 1:5 says,

"If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally --- and it will be given to him

This God' wisdom will be given to us when we humbly ask – and we can totally depend on this wisdom for every issue of life. With this wisdom, we don't need to worry about, what we will say (Luke 21:15) or what we will eat or wear; God's wisdom through His Spirit is all-sufficient for everything and for every area of our lives.

Do you want this wisdom?

Remember, it is through the Holy Spirit who searches all things.

You need to receive the Holy Spirit of God into your life; He is the promise of God to all His children (Acts 2:39).

Apostle Stephen spoke with this God given wisdom and no one was able to resist or counter his words; ask for the Holy Spirit and with Him, no one will be able to resist your knowledge.

THINK IT OUT

Do you want this God-given wisdom to go through life?

PRAYER:

Dear Father thank You for the promise and the gift of the Holy Spirit. Dear Holy Spirit come into my life today and abide with me forever. Teach me, guide me in life and give me the wisdom I need to live life successfully.

WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 11 WHAT IS YOUR CUSTOM?

Custom as we know, can be habits we do regularly or a practice that is common to many and has been long established. They could also be practices that have been an integral part of us, such that we believe, it is impossible to let go.

So it's either we've become entrapped by them or we are ruled with fear by them. Some of these customs, we inherited them from our fathers, and we have come to know that they are of no profit to us at all, yet we are afraid to let go.

Others are habit we believe are inherent or are in our blood, so we are powerless.

Jesus came to set us free from the entanglement and slavery of the laws, and customs of our fathers. He also came to rescue us from self-destructive habits that we are trapped in. His message is, "Repent for the kingdom is at hand" (Matt.4:17).

Meaning, change direction; come into this realm, where there is freedom from fear and victory from destruction.

One will expect that people who have lived with so much terror and pain would quickly embrace this freedom message; but no, just like the people in our today's text who said, "We are Romans, it is not lawful for us to receive this";

today we are still resisting the change that the gospel of Christ is asking of us, with excuses like,

"In my place, that is how we behave"; "That is just who I am"; or even more convincing, "Conditions of life or my experiences in life, or my nature of work; have transform me to this".

Without doubt, those things may be very true, but with God,

"All things are possible" (Lk.18:27).

If in humility, we receive Jesus into our lives, and whole heartedly ask Him to help us with those area of our lives, and if we'll be submissive to the leading of the Holy Spirit; we might not just miraculously change in one day, but with the help of the Holy Spirit; gradual transformation will occur, which will in the course of time, reveal in us a whole new man in Christ. This is what Christ paid for, when He gave His life on the cross.

THINK IT OUT

Do you know that being a new man in Christ means all old things- traditions and customs passes away, and all things becomes new?

PRAYER:

Thank You dear Lord Jesus for giving Your life to set us free. Today, I surrender and ask for help..

COMMUNICATING WITH GOD

'However when the Spirit of truth has come'

This was Jesus promise to His disciple before His departure.

This promise was fulfilled (John 14:16-17).

Another thing to note about this promise is that Jesus said the Holy Spirit, will abide with us forever, He will dwell with us and will be in us.

These are the things Jesus said the Holy Spirit will do in us when He comes:

'He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come'.

Jesus here was telling us about the relationship we will have with God the Father because of the work of redemption and reconciliation which He will accomplish for us at the cross. Of course after we have been reconciled to God, we have a relationship with God, and in every good relationship there must be communication.

Now it is through the abiding Holy Spirit that we communicate with God.

Jesus said, '*The Holy Spirit will guide us into all truth'* – when we know the truth about God; who He is and how much He loves us, we will be more intimate in our relationship with Him; and in appreciation for His love; and in reverence, we will be obedient to His word.

He also said,

"The Holy Spirit will speak whatever He

hears", that is to say, 'When God says something to us, the Holy Spirit will tell us – not only that, when we also speak to God [in prayer], though we may not know, sometimes the right words or even what we should ask for, the Holy Spirit will communicate even our heart groanings to God.

"Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered" (Rom.8:26).

And He will also bring back word from God to us.

Jesus said, "*He will tell you things to come*" meaning He will declare the mind of God concerning our request to us; giving us hope and a clear picture of what to expect.

THINK IT OUT

Are you in relationship with God? Have you communicated today?

PRAYER:

Thank You dear Lord for choosing to be in constant communication with us. Thank You for the Holy Spirit who is always with us to help us..

FRIDAY DECEMBER 13 GIVING ALL FOR JESUS' NAME

Jesus gave all to rescue us. He laid down His life for us to have life. He left His throne in heaven, came down, humbled Himself to be beaten, spat on, crowned with thorns and crucified – not for the sins He committed, because Pilate said,

"I have found no reason for death in Him" (Luke 23:22)

Yet, He was crucified.

Why? He did this that we might be forgiven of our sins; be saved and be reconciled to God forever.

He gave all for love. No wonder when Apostle Paul, who was formally persecuting those who called on that name; when he was shown mercy, when the love of Christ was revealed to him; when he received and tasted the love of Christ, he was determined to give his all, even his life for that name. He said, "For I am ready not only to be bound, but also to die for the name of Jesus"

What about you, have you received His mercy?

What area of your life can you say, 'His love has been revealed to me'?

Is there something you know, or something that has reminded you of His love, that will make you give your all for Him and for the glory of His name?

You may say, 'Well not much', but have you thought about the sacrifice He made to reconcile you to God, your maker? Now you can call on God as your Father and also you are a child of God all because of Him.

Hence, what will you withhold from Him? What is that thing that you think is too much to let go for His sake?

Today, if you will choose to let it go for the name of Jesus, you won't be missing anything – because whatever you let go, He is well able to give you much more, even better, a hundred fold.

Think about it.

THINK IT OUT


What are you willing to give for His name? Do you know how much He loves you?

What forms your view point: what are the

basis of your reasoning?

Most times we allow situations to form our judgment.

Other times, the Politics of the day; the Economy; the Weather for that period; or even sometimes, it is our feelings for that particular day, that we allow to be the basis of our reasoning and judgment.

Though all these things might be the facts or the real situation of things, even then, they should not form our reasoning or our perception of life.

In Christ Jesus, the only thing that matter is the truth of what the scripture says. It does not matter how we may feel or what the economy or the weather says; or who is the head of Government, nor our family background; the word of God always stand true in all situation.

Apostle Paul's custom was to reason from the view point of the scriptures, then it is written, "Some of them were persuaded" (V.4). When we accept Jesus, we are expected to believe His word.

Everything God has provided for us in Christ Jesus, we take possession of them by believing.

- Be it our healing (1Pet.2:24); Forgiveness
- (Col.1:14, 1John 1:9);

Prosperity and Security (Lk.17:33, Jude 1:1), all have been provided in Christ; we accept and receive them when we believe. So let your reasoning or your perspective of life's subjects be from what the scripture says. Judge everything with the scripture, feed your mind with the word of God and lay hold on the promises it provide.

Be persuaded by the truth and live by the truth.

Know that Truth always cancelled out Fact. God's word is truth, situation of life are only facts of the moment and they are temporal; but Truth, remains forever.

THINK IT OUT

How are you going to reason today, or what will form your judgment? Do you know it will be more profitable if you begin to align yourself with what the word of God says?

PRAYER:

Dear Lord thank You that all I need and will ever need has been provided in Your word; and I only need to take by believing.

DIS-ENGAGE FROM EVIL

It is common today that people want to belong to one social group or more. Some, desiring so much to belong have been lured into wrong associations or even evil associations which like those in our today's texts have bound themselves by oath for evil.

And for the fear of this oath and pledges, they have remain under bondage and there seems no way out.

If you have found yourself in this evil entanglement, and you truly want to disengage, there is good news for you. Jesus said, "I have come as a light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness" (John 12:46).

And also it is written that Jesus came, "to give light to those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death" (Lk.1:79). His command is, "Come out from among them and be separate, -- do not touch what is unclean and I will receive you. I will be a Father to you and you shall be My sons and daughters" (2Cor.6:17-18).

You may say, "I am afraid, how do I come out?"

Jesus said, "If you believe". The power to disengage is in you believing that Jesus can save you.

The Scripture says, "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12)

Since, there is no other name, if you believe

in the name that God gave for everyone to be saved, you shall be save.

Believing in Jesus makes you a child of God and He your Father; and this is the key, and this is where the power to disengage comes from.

You can invite Jesus into your life right now, if you are willing, by praying this prayer and believing in your heart:

Dear Lord Jesus, I am a sinner, I am sorry for all my sins, I repent, please forgive me and cleanse me with Your blood. I believe You are the Son of God. Come into my life and make me Your child. I receive You as my Lord and Savior today. Amen

MONDAY DECEMBER 16 DO YOU WANT TO BE MADE WELL?

Jesus' question to a sick man whom He knew had been there for a long time, may have sounded surprising or even offensive. The man could have said, "Can't You see I am sick and I have been lying here with no one to help? Or simply,

"Why would I not want to be made well, do you think I enjoy this sickness?"

But the sick man instead of picking offense responded in humility, "Sir, I have no man to put me into the pool", just like saying, "Sir, I really want to, but I need help from someone".

Jesus' question was to find out, if the sick man was willing and ready to receive the healing when he is given. This shows that, as powerful and as able as Jesus is, He still need our consent to save us.

If the sick man was not willing, but Jesus releases the healing, the man would not have received it and if he did not received it, he would not have it.

So our consent and permission is needed.

The story of the woman, who had a flow of blood for twelve years, the scripture said, she made up her mind; decided in her heart and said, "If only I may touch His cloths, I shall be made well".

She consented in her heart and permitted the healing power of Jesus with her believe. 'And immediately the fountain of her blood dried up' such that Jesus felt something and turned around to ask, 'who touched Me' [she did not wait for Jesus to lay hands on her but she touched and with her believe pulled healing power out of Jesus] when Jesus asked and she came forward, Jesus said, "Daughter, your faith has made you well" (Mark 5:25,27-34)

I tell you, your believe and permission is paramount and overriding.

So, are you sick?

Do you want to be made well?

Healing is available now; use your

determined and believing heart to receive it

now in Jesus name, Amen.


THINK IT OUT

SEEK TO KNOW MORE

Apollos was first described as a man who was instructed in the way of the Lord and then a man who was fervent [on fire, zealous] in spirit. He came to Ephesus, preaching and teaching the things of the Lord with 'accuracy' – though he knew only the baptism of John [the baptism of repentance (Matt.3:11)].

He did not know about the baptism of Jesus – which is described in 1Peter 3:21, as "The answer of a good conscience toward God".

Also Apostle Paul explains it to the Romans thus:

"Do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead – even so we also should walk in newness of life" (Rom.6:3-4).

This truth, Apollos was not taught, but he had a teachable spirit, though he was a minister, he humbly accepted when this was pointed out to him by Aquila and Priscilla his wife.

The scripture says,

"They took him aside and explained to him the way of God 'more accurately" (Acts 18:26).

He grew spiritually and went on to be Apostle Paul's very useful partner (Titus 3:13, 1Cor.16:12)

leaving us an example of a teachable, open hearted, fervent minister of the gospel of Christ.

Remember the Scripture said he was teaching the things of the Lord with accuracy; but what he later had was a more accurate way of the Lord, and this helped both him and his listeners.

The questions are: Are we teachable? Why is there so much disparity in doctrines amongst believers today?

Preaching and teaching will be more profitable and it will yield more fruit if those who preach or teach, will be willing to know the more accurate way of the things of God, by being teachable.

THINK IT OUT

Do you know that wrong teachings produces a negative impart to those who listen? And do you know you can humbly ask the Holy Spirit to guide you into the whole truth?

PRAYER:

Dear Lord Jesus, help us to be humble, open hearted and teachable, so that we will not go out to spread distorted gospel and destroy the work You shed Your blood on the cross for.

WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 18 SEEK REVELATION

Revelation is usually a way the divine truth is being communicated to us by the Holy Spirit.

It was Jesus' promise to send the Holy Spirit; The Spirit of Truth; and The Helper to His

followers.

He said, "When He, the Spirit of truth has come, He will guide you into all truth [the correct picture of things], -- and He will tell you things to come [bring to light hidden things].

He also said, the Helper will teach you all things [help us to understand the things of God by giving us lesson from the word of God] and bring to our remembrance all things Jesus had told us [remind us what the scriptures says concerning a particular issue] (John14:26). It is written, "Where there is no revelation, the people [perish] (Prov.29:18).

Jesus never intended His followers to walk alone and be led by whatever their natural senses tell them.

Instead He wants us who are His followers to be led by His Spirit, taught by His Spirit and be strengthen by His Spirit.

We cannot walk the new way with Christ successfully without His guidance and we cannot walk godly in this world of trouble without the revelation of what our hope of following Him and enduring the tribulations of this world, is. Jesus Himself was on this earth, He did not walk alone, He couldn't have accomplished the Father's will alone.

He said, "I am not alone, but I am with the Father who sent Me" Also, "I can of Myself do nothing" (John 8:16, 5:30).

If we are ever going to succeed living for Him, we need the guidance of the Holy Spirit; to endure to the end, we need the revelation of His Spirit. Otherwise even our best will be only but vain and our race might be anti-clockwise of the direction God want us to take. Paul said, 'I went up by revelation, - lest I had run in vain"

THINK IT OUT

Are you running by revelation, or by self determination?

PRAYER:

Dear Lord Jesus, really I can't walk alone and please You, I need the Holy Spirit guidance. Sweet Holy Spirit come into my life, reveal the will of My Father, so that I can walk in it.

Jesus came specifically to reconcile the once broken relationship between man and God. He atoned with His blood, the sins of disobedience committed from Adam and became the mediator for all who will believe and come to God through faith in His finished work.

He said, "I am the door, if anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture" (John 10:9). If you have entered by Jesus [the only door], then know that, it is because of Him, that you are in God, and not because of your doctrines or mode of worship.

Everyone who believe is joined together into this one source, he or she forms a branch and we all as branches are joined together and partakes of the same bread – the Vine, thus making us one in Christ.

What is the thing that matters most in your relationship with the Lord? Are you saved because of the denomination you belong to?

PRAYER:

Dear Lord Jesus, thank You for the finished work of the cross. And thank You for making me worthy to be called a child of God. May I focus on what is important and view other children as one in You.

Apostle John also wrote saying,

"Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is" (1John 3:2). On that 'Day' everything will be made clear, all the works we have done, will also be revealed and we will understand all mysteries; each one's work will become clear and tested by fire; rewards and crowns will be given.

Sadness and rejoicing; regrets and consolations will fill the air. We know for sure that this 'Day' will come. So, what are you doing about this truth? Planning for it or ignoring it?

THINK IT OUT

Have you ask yourself what will the 'Day' reveal about my work? If all is brought to light will I be proud or ashamed

PRAYER:

Lord Jesus thank You for this truth, help me not to ignore it. Guide me to live everyday planning for it, so that I will receive the crown of righteousness and be consoled.

In a period where preaching the gospel was a crime or when even acknowledging publicly that you are a believer was a risk to life; Faithful believers who truly have accepted the Lord Jesus as their Lord and Savior, stood together to encourage each other and to spur each other for good works.

Apostle Paul took courage when he arrived Rome as a prisoner for the gospel of Christ, brethren from far and near came out to meet him and identify with him in his sufferings.

You may ask, "Do we still have such unity today?

Do believers still identify with the sufferings of their fellow believers and encourage them?

Well maybe not really much, especially now that we are divided by denominations. Be that as it may, though we might not see a physical figure standing by our bedside when we are sick or a visit from a brethren when we are down; we are still not alone on our journey of faith.

Hebrews 12 begins with,

"Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witness, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sins that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us" (V.1).

We are surrounded by great saints and ordinary people who endured to the end in the Bible and they encourage us by their example.

Hebrews 11 describes heroes of the faith who faced great trials and remained loyal to God. For everyday encouragement, go to the scripture, take courage from the story of the faithful and how God stood with them.

And also, from His promise:

"I will never leave you nor forsake you" (Heb.13:5)

Do you need encouragement to go on? Do you know just like David you can encourage yourself in the Lord by reading the story of the past heros in the Scriptures?

It made no sense for a widow to donate her last few coins away; where was she expecting to get the next meal from? But in that woman's act, Jesus saw a moving display of the proper attitude toward money, and He said,

"Assuredly, --this poor widow has put in more than all" (Mk.12:41-43).

The lesson we should learn here is not in trying to give more than others, but learning that, it benefit the giver more than the receiver.

In her act, she expressed the confidence she has in God's provision.

She trust that God will care for her. So instead of clinging to the last coin – which will not even sustain her – she let it go, loss grip of it and was able to focus by faith on the one who is well able to keep and satisfy her, like the birds and the flowers that do not need to worry about their future. (Matt.6:25-34)

Giving, reminds the giver that he or she, is living by the grace of God. When we give, we are actually expressing our trust in the faithfulness of God's words and putting our dependency on His ability to provide for us.

We all have things that we are holding so dear, and in our heart, 'This is all we have, it is not even sufficient, so there is no way we will give it out'.

That might be the one thing that is preventing our trust and dependency on God's provision; also it is the very thing that is robbing us our blessings.

Will you rather let that go, so that you will focus and come to know the blessedness that comes from giving out and trusting God's provisions?

THINK IT OUT

Why keep the last coin, that is not even enough to take care of you? Do you know you can break the power of limitation by letting go and trusting God for provision?

PRAYER:

Dear Lord thank You for teaching me how to be blessed. Give me the willing heart to let go the few and trust that You are faithful to provide and sustain me better than I can do for myself.

MONDAY DECEMBER 23 HEART CIRCUMCISION

The heart can be defined as, our innermost character, our feelings, or our inclinations. It is our emotional or moral nature which is different from our spirit or even intellectual nature.

With this definition, it shows the heart acts independently of our intelligent – and this is where the problem lies.

Sometimes the heart's inclination tends towards: anger, bitterness, retaliation,

self-defense, pride and all other vices; but in our intellect, we know these things are not in conformity with the teachings of our Savior; we would have love to obey and be humble but our heart emotions seems must times to get the upper hand.

Apostle Paul said,

"o wretched man that I am! Who will deliver

me from this body of death?" (Rom.7:24) That is to say, we carry about the body of death, whose inclination is both worldly and contrary to things of the spirit.

Because of this, we constantly need a practical heart circumcision; and this can be done by consulting the word always, and comparing with what our heart is tending to.

The battle with the heart inclinations is a life-long battle.

So to keep it in check and under control always, we need the cleansing word; the word of truth and the word of our salvation every day or more often especially when we have a heart-attack. To keep the heart circumcised always, is to have a constant heart-check.

When we are filled with the Word of God it is easy to arrest the inclinations of our fleshly heart and circumcise it with the purifying Word;

and Paul said,

'Your praise will not be from men, but from God Himself'

THINK IT OUT

How often do you compare your words, actions and thought to the teachings of the Scriptures that you know and believe?

PRAYER:

Dear Lord Jesus thank You for making a way out of our emotional inclination. Help me through Your word to circumcise my heart and obey Your teaching, through the help of Your Spirit..

salvation of the soul that draws heaven. Jesus uses the parables of: "The Lost Sheep"; "The Lost Coin"; and "The Lost Son" in Luke 15, to illustrate what the salvation of a soul produces in heaven.

He said, "I say to you that there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance" (V.7).

Why would there be such joy?

Because for the souls of man, Jesus left His throne in heaven, came to earth and hung on the cross to redeem.

It is only the salvation of the soul that can bring about a concurrence joy in heaven and in earth, this is the best kind of joy.

Let us all who have received this joy reach out to those one souls and spark a joy in heaven.

The best joy is when a soul meets with his Savior.

THURSDAY DECEMBER 26 WHAT IS THE WILL OF GOD?

Ephesians 5:17 says, "Do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is"; We may be wondering what really is God's will?

What does God want for me and from me? Then the next question is 'What God want from me, will it be too difficult for me to carry out?

Let's look at God's will for us first: the will of God for us all is that, "No one should perish"

Jesus told us saying,

"It is not the will of My Father that anyone –

- should perish" (Matt.18:14);

and for the sake of this will, He sent His only begotten Son Jesus Christ, to bear the punishment for our sins, so that He will redeem us from death and give us eternal life. (John 3:16).

We can see that His will for us is good and that His heart long for us for good. Then what does He want from us? He want everyone to come to the knowledge of this truth, believe it and willingly accept the offer of salvation which the death of His Son offers.

Right now He is holding back, waiting for every one of us to repent [turn around] and be saved. (2Pet.3:9)

- He told Paul, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness" (2Cor.12:9).
- When we are willing, our weakness is subsumed in His strength.
- Jesus our master surrendered His life for the Father's will and God glorified Him.
- If we are willing, God grace is ever sufficient, and at the end we will be glorified with Christ.

It is actually reported that there is sexual immorality among you, and such sexual immorality as is not even named among the Gentiles [unbelievers] – that a man has his father's wife! 1CORINTHIANS 5:1

Sexual immorality seems to be more tolerated or the news of it received with only laughter among believers today.

More so, it does not seems to bother the

church, which is supposed to be the body of Christ, neither do the perpetrators of the acts, feel any sense of guilt for wrong doings.

It is viewed just like any other wrong doings – stealing, cursing, lying or bearing false witness.

It is not the worst sin after all; it is just the weakness of the flesh.

Let's look how the scripture treats it: first Apostle Paul, on hearing the news of sexual immorality, said,

"Deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh – [so] that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus" (V.5). This shows that, anytime you embark on the journey of sexual immorality; you have willingly handed power over your body to Satan.

Satan begins to wreak havoc on the body – no wonder there are STD [Sexually Transmitted Diseases] everywhere.

Even while still in the sin, we begin to pray, commanding healing, and rebuking Satan; and make it seems as if God does not answer prayers anymore.

Meanwhile, Apostle Paul wrote, "Do you not know that, [the body you handed over to Satan] is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have from God and [that body is] not your own? For you were bought at a price" (1Cor.6:19-20).

Then on a very strong terms he said, "Do you not know that [your body is] the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in [that body]?

Therefore know this, "If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are" (1Cor.3:16-17)

This does not seems like just a laughing matter, it is quiet serious, so sexual immorality should be resented amongst believers.

THINK IT OUT

Is the Spirit of God dwelling in you? Do you accept that you are God's temple?

PRAYER:

Dear Lord, please help me not to be complacence over sexual sins. Give me the grace to earnestly keep my body as a holy temple for Your dwelling.

WHEN WE CRY

David said, "O God, be merciful to me! For my soul trusts in You; and in the shadow of Your wings I will make my refuge, until these calamities have passed by" (V.1)

When calamity struck; when you are oppressed or when you lose something that is so dear to you – could be, your health, freedom, your peace or even your means of survival – whose attention do you seek?

Who do you cry to? Do you look on men

and be angry why they are not helping you? Or to Government and blame them for corruption?

Maybe even to relations and then complain, how they have no love in the family?

Even if all these are true, and also partly the reason why you are suffering; they are not the solution.

David said, 'I cry to the one who performs all things for me'.

Why don't you take your own to the one who can perform all things?

The scripture says,

"The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, and His ears are [always] open to their cry" (Ps.34:15)

His ears are always open.

THINK IT OUT

When you cry whose attention are you seeking, man's or God's? Who does your soul trust?

PRAYER:

Oh Lord my God, I cry to You for my soul trust in You. Be merciful to me and hide me in Your shadow till this calamity have passed by, Amen..

He says, "COME TO ME".

Don't carry it alone, Apostle Peter's advice is, "Cast [that] burden upon Him, for He cares for you" (1Pet.5:7)

Remember He already knows, and beside He cares.

Your work is to cast the cares;

His work is to take care, so do your part and cast that care today and He will faithfully give you peace.

THINK IT OUT

Do you trust His love? Why then are you caring the burden alone?

PRAYER:

Dear Lord Jesus, thank You, that You know and care about my heart. Today I cast all my cares and burdens to You, and I leave them with You to take care and give me peace, Amen

A hope that He purchased for us at the cross, when He poured His blood and died for our sins. A hope when He resurrected the third day to justify us freely (Rom.4:25);

and a more sure hope, now that He is seated at the Father's right hand as our advocate (Rom.8:34, 1John 2:1).

Then the most sure hope when He shall return to take us home, to that place where He went to prepare (John 14:3). A place where God will wipe away our tears; and where there will be no more death, no sorrow, no crying, no pain. (Rev.21:4)
