What steps can you take today that can really show-case Christ? Do you know it is never too late to start?



activities?

Is this all we have to show as proves for our
faith in Christ?
What about, if the person we really need to
convince of our faith, is ourselves?

It may sound unreasonable for you to think
that you need to convince yourself about
your faith in Christ, but the scripture says,
“The Spirit (of God) Himself bears witness
with our spirit that we are children of God”
(Rom. 8:16).

The Spirit of God will not take people's opinion, nor bear witness about you based on what people say you are.

What you agree, believe and say you are, is what the Holy Spirit bears witness to.

So, if you are truly convinced in your heart about your faith in Christ – remember, this is not being dutiful in religious activities, but a genuine conviction and believe in who Jesus is; and the relationship you have with Him because you believe; the His Spirit will bear you witness.

So your witness and the witness of the Spirit of God in you; these two internal testimonies of your faith will definitely reflect in your outward life; that people around you and

those who know you will find distinct and unmistakably true about you and talk about.

Do you know convincing yourself about your faith is the most important spiritual activities you need to engage in daily?



AUTHORITY GIVEN FOR EDIFICATION

We as believers and followers of our Lord
Jesus Christ have been bestowed or endowed
with authority in the name of Jesus.

The authority we have over another person, according to Paul, is the '**authority for edification**' and not '**authority for destruction**'.

But there is another authority that we have been given;

In Ephesians 1:20-22, the Scripture says, that Jesus was raised from the dead and He is seated at God's right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principalities and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come, and all things are put under His feet.

Then in chapter 2:4,6 it is recorded that we who have believed and accepted Him; because of God's great love towards us, have been raised up together and have been made to sit in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus – and it is also far above principality, powers, might, dominion and every name.

We have been raised up with Christ and given authority over every spiritual and physical dominions and powers.

But the authority we have over each other as members of Christ body or as humans created in His image and likeness, is the authority for edification –

Edification means, to instruct or inform in a way that improves the mind or character.

We are given authority to instruct and inform each other for the glory of God, because what we have is the Spirit of Christ that came to seek and to save that which was lost.

(Luke 19:10).

So we who are Christ's, have been given authority to seek, save and deliver.

THINK IT OUT

Do you know the authority you have towards each other and towards

principalities and powers? Are you using it properly?


PRAYER:

WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 4

WE ARE INDESTRUCTIBLE

The scripture says,

“And the Lord God formed man of the dust
of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils
the breath of life; and man became a living
being (Gen.2:7).

This scripture points us to who man is, and what man is made of as a living being - The very breath of God.

This is important to God who gave the breath in the first place.

So no one has the permission to take away the breath from another man.

Paul describe his escape from the hands of the governor of Damascus, who set up garrison of soldiers to guard the city, desiring to arrest Paul (V.32), but Paul said, 'I escape from his hands';

Paul had the protection of God and the governor could do nothing except it is being granted to him by God.

Every believer has the same protection of God, because our life is highly valued and we belong to Him; no one has the right to take your life.

Jesus said,

“I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly” (John 10:10).

He also said,

“And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hands” (v.28).

Why then should we be afraid?

Eternal life, means life unending.

Therefore, what every believer have, is the life that has no end because the one who is

life, lives on the inside of us, to both preserve and sustains us for His own glory.

So go out with the full assurance of life and providence because the one who lives forever lives inside of you – He is in you, with you and for you – you are indestructible.

Do you know that Jesus gave up His own life so that you will have life in full? Do you know what you have is eternal life?


PRAYER:

So Jesus' advice to the church that is called faithful was, “Hold fast what you have, that no one may

take your crown”.

What is that thing which you have, that is worth keeping?

Apostle Paul said,

“There is laid up for me a crown of righteousness” (2Tim.4:8).

Apostle James talked about a “Crown of life” for those who endured temptation (James 1:12).

Then Apostle Peter talks about the “Crown of glory” for those shepherds who serves as overseers over the flocks of God faithfully, not for dishonest gains and not lording over those that are entrusted to them, but instead serving as an example for the flocks to follow. (1Peter 5:2-4).

These are just three crowns mentioned here, there are many more crowns that people will be crowned with.

Whichever crown you have been able to secure, do not let anyone take that crown from you

PRAYER:



We in this present generation are also receiving the same warnings, that the

“heavens and the earth which are now preserved by God's word, are reserved for fire until the day of judgment” (2Pet.3:7).

We should not think that it will be impossible for God to end this world.

If He did it in Noah's generation when He warned; then He will do it in this present generation.

If all our labor is for earthly possession and for fleshly satisfaction, we will lose them all for the fire that will consume the earth and the heavens.

Apostle Peter admonishes us saying, “Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved by fire, what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness” (2Peter 3:11).

To be on the safe side, be that manner of person that also endeavor to labor for eternity.

Are all your labor going to be burned up by fire? Are you identifying and increasing your labors that are for eternity?



**CHRIST IS THE
HEAD OVER ALL**

According to the scriptures, it is God's will and purpose that through Jesus, the Christ and Messiah; the whole world would be saved.

Jesus Christ is the only one that bore the sins of the whole world and died for it.

Hebrew 9:26 says,

“He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself”.

Therefore, He is the only qualified captain of our salvation” (Heb.2:10).

He is also able to save all who come to God through Him. (Heb.7:25)

Apostle Paul wrote,

“God has made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purpose in Himself, that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which

are on earth – in Him” (Eph. 1:9-10).

Though in time past when the prophesy came it was a mystery, but now Paul said, 'God has made it known to us that it is His will to gather all things in Christ'.

Therefore “He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things”.

So those who see Him as a Prophet comparable with other prophets, have gotten it wrong.

Also, those who see Him as only Mary's baby, are not completely correct.

Jesus Christ is the head over all things; be it on earth and in heaven.

And the fullness of the Godhead, dwells in Him (Col.1:19).

Therefore know that there is no other name higher or comparable, or even to be mentioned along side His name.

Jesus is the CHRIST, the MESSIAH, the SAVIOR, and His is LORD and head over all things.

THINK IT OUT

What does the name of Jesus mean to you?
Is He just a Prophet to you? Do you only consider Him as Savior, and not as Lord?


Do you also accept His Lordship over your life?

SUNDAY FEBRUARY 8

**NOW HE IS HERE
WITH US**

A man named Lazarus was sick, his sister, Martha sent to Jesus saying, “Lord, he whom you love is sick” (V.1 – 3).

Showing that, this family knew Jesus and were His friends.

But the distance between them was a two days journey; and Jesus also stayed two more days before embarking on this journey; so by the time He got there, Lazarus had died and was already buried for four days.

The sister seeing Jesus, said,

“Lord, if you had been here my brother would not have died”.

In Martha and Lazarus days, Jesus had to go to them physically for them to see Jesus, and tell Him their problems.

But now, we no longer have to wait for His arrival; because He is in us always.

We talk to Him, and He talks with us;
He hears our request and answers
immediately.

This is because He came to earth to establish
a relationship.

He told His disciples,
“I will not leave you orphans; I will come to
you”

He also said this,
“If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word
and My Father will love him, and We will
come to him and make Our home with him.

-- At that day you will know that I am in My
Father, and you in Me, and I in you”
(John 14:18, 23, 20).

Because of this, everyone who believes and

loves Jesus, has this advantage of a personal relationship with Christ.

Apostle John wrote,

“By this we know that we abide in Him, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit” (1John 4:13).

If you have His Spirit, 'this is Christ living in you'.

Again, this is not about the church you go, nor the position you hold in the church, but about the relationship He came to establish.

Do you have Christ living in you? Are you

in relationship with Christ or are you
practicing religion?



FAITH, RECEIVES ALL

When God made a promise to Abraham; Abraham believed God, the scripture says, “He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in

faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.

And therefore 'it was accounted to him for righteousness'" (V.20-22).

Abraham received every promises God made to him and also a "sign of circumcision, which is a seal of the righteousness of faith which he had in God.

God counted Abraham's beliefs as righteousness.

Paul went further to say,

"Now it was not written for his sake alone that it was imputed to him, but also for us.

It shall be imputed to us who believe in Him who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead".

(Rom. 4:23-24).

It pleases God - when He promised, we believe.

Everyone who believes the salvation work God sent His Son Jesus to do on the cross, is righteous before God.

Also, everyone who believes the promises Jesus made, will receive everything Jesus promised.

The scripture also said,

“He who does not believe God has made Him a liar” (1John 5:10).

Jesus also said, “He who does not believe is condemned already” (John 3:18).

You can receive every promises of Christ by

believing, and you can lose everything by not believing.

Know that believe is a righteous acts, that pleases God. But you have a choice.

Do you believe Jesus and the promises He made to those who believes? Do you know you need to believe to receive from Him?



TUESDAY FEBRUARY 10

CONFORMING TO ESCAPE SUFFERING

Many mindless religious activities we carry out in our Churches calls for questioning.

Some did not start today; in the early church;

Paul talked about Apostles who went about

compelling people to circumcise and follow the Jewish customs, so that they may not suffer persecutions for the cross of Christ.

This trend of conforming to escape persecution and suffering is the order of our religious circle today.

Many leaders will tell their followers to perform certain religious activities and doctrines as services to God so that God will accept them.

All these is to make their teaching appears religious; and Paul calls it 'a show in the flesh'.

Most religious rite and engagement we do, is to appear good before people and some to

escape being accuse of not conforming. This is because we care so much about what people will say; 'How people will view us and 'if people will accept us'.

But we have not ask ourselves, "Does God approves this?" Or "Who am I serving, God or man?" Some preachers and teachers who have found out the truth about certain subject cannot apply the truth because they will be criticized.

That is why some very popular religious rituals that are clearly seen to be contrary to the teachings of Jesus, are still in existence today, because the followers lack courage to

question the significance of these rituals.

But if you will want to know: Jesus came to give you a personal relationship with God that is not based on people's opinion nor on their endorsement.

His death on the cross was to make you blameless, perfect and qualified to be in relationship with God.

This is what you are expected to believe to receive the free gift of salvation that Jesus paid for.

So don't be so engaged in religious rituals that are men's idea and not God's.

Do you want the truth or do you want men acceptance? Do you want a personal relationship with God or you want a religious show?


PRAYER:

THINK IT OUT


What else do you think you can put your trust on to carry you to the very end without shame?

THURSDAY FEBRUARY 12

UNNECESSARY BURDEN

The Apostles in Acts 15 gathered to deliberate about the issue of circumcision which some devoted Jews, who though have become believers, yet held on to the customs

and laws and were teaching others, “unless you are circumcised according to the custom of Moses, you cannot be saved” (V.1).

When the Apostles gathered they did not just deliberate based on their own knowledge and based on laid down doctrines; but they opened their heart to the Holy Spirit – who is the Helper and the Teacher.

And because they seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit, they were able to write to the Gentile believers saying,

“For it seemed good to the Holy Spirit, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden”.

Truly, “Be circumcised according to the law of Moses”, was an unnecessary burden. Salvation is only through believing in the

work Jesus accomplished on the cross.

The sacrifice Jesus did on the cross was complete and total, requiring no additional work nor rituals.

So what unnecessary religious burden are you carrying today?

Are you sure God wants you carry it?

when you are doing something in the name of God that He Himself did not ask you to, then you are carrying an unnecessary burden

We can each save ourselves unnecessary burden if we make it a matter of importance to always seek the guidance and leading of the Holy Spirit in our daily decisions.

What religious burden are you carrying?

Have you asked the Holy Spirit if it seemed good to Him? And how long have you been carrying unnecessary personal burdens that the Holy Spirit would have given you the way out long ago if you have asked?

PRAYER:


Dear Lord Jesus my Savior thank You for not laying any burden on me to save me.

It is dangerous to preach the word of God with craftiness; because those who do that are aiding and working for Satan.

The word of God, comes with a convicting power to reproof, correct, instructs and

purify those who will pay attention and receive it with joy; as such anyone handling the word with craftiness will forfeit the benefit that comes with it.

Apostle Paul addressed the Corinthians saying

“You were crafty yet I caught you by cunning”.

The gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ is goodnews to all because, it brings salvation to all who believe.

The gospel does not contain any hidden code, nor is it so mysterious that one cannot understand.

Those who handle the word with craftiness have made it complicated, untrustworthy

and even boring for those who are ignorant.

This is no surprise, we should know that Satan who is the enemy of man, will do all he can to hinder the gospel of Christ from reaching people; including using man against man, by introducing counterfeit.

In the parable of the sower, Jesus explained that the sower, sowed the seed, which is the word of God. Then some fell on the way side.

These are hearts which received the word but did not understand so, the devil comes and snatched away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved (Luke 8:11-12).

If we are truly seeking the truth, Jesus said,
“I am the light of the world. He who
follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but
shall have the light of life” (John 8:12)

If you truly seek to know the truth, you will
get the truth, because Jesus came as light,
you can not search the Scripture for the truth
and not get it.

Therefore both preachers of the word and
hearers of the word stop being crafty with it;
because we are all together on one side,
while the devil is on the opposite side.
He is not on anyone side.

THINK IT OUT

Are you receiving the benefit of the word of life? And, have you search to be sure you are getting the truth? Who are you aiding?



PRAYER:



The other branches on the false vine, do not need dressing because the vine from its root is corrupt, and so will its branches be.

As such the false vine and its branches need to be uprooted from its root and cast away.

But the branches of the true vine, because its root is upright and righteous; the branches only need dressing to make them look beautiful in appearance and grow to bear more fruit.

Then in verse 2, Jesus said:

“Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit the Father takes away and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit”.

Here the branches on the true vine are dressed by the Father, to bear fruit.

But if after much dressing, the branches that are barren or those who have refuse to bear fruit, the Father will take them away from the vine; giving room for those who bears fruit to be pruned for more fruit.

With these explanations it shows that those, though were on the true vine yet refuse to bear fruit or just simply stay barren, will also be cut off just like those who grow on a false vine.

The vine here is Jesus, and the branches are we who believe in Him.

We are shown by these analysis that growth and fruit bearing are a matter of necessity,

being in Christ.

We must first grow in our knowledge of Him, and then bear the fruit that tells the vine we grow on.

THINK IT OUT

Which vine are you growing on? Do you know that growing on the true vine, you must bear fruit? Do you know that only those who bear fruit, will be pruned for more fruit?



As such God will make all grace abound toward us, that we, always having all sufficiency in all things may have abundance for every good works”.

We become a funnel through which this world would be blessed.

God never stops pouring into the funnel, so that you will never cease to flow; and have abundance for every good works.

There is abundance for good works if you will engage in it.

Why pray and seek for abundance that you can easily have, by who you become? If you are a new creation, are you doing good works?



“normal life” is like toiling through the night without a catch; just as the disciples found out.

But Jesus did not abandon them to face life on their own, neither has He abandon us; He is always on hand to help.

Because He was standing on the shore with breakfast and was only waiting for them to come and eat.

“Have you any food”? Do you know help


is available if you allow Him be part of your 'normal life'?

Notice, the forgiveness was already made available even before you sinned, Rom. 5:8 says, “But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us”.

God did not wait for you to repent and become good before He sent forgiveness; but His forgiveness came first.

Jesus Christ through His death on the cross had made a down payment for sin – There is nothing left for you to do, only that you should accept the forgiveness of your sins.

When you believe this, and ask for forgiveness, you have accepted His forgiveness; then, you need to forgive

yourself, for you are not greater than God who forgave you.

Then also learn to forgive others who have hurt you, just as God forgave you for Christ's sake.

Make this a pattern of your life and sin will not have dominion over you.

After reading through this, do you still think you have excuse for dwelling in sin? What excuse will you give?

PRAYER:


Dear Lord Jesus, indeed I have no excuse for dwelling in sin. Today I lay down all my sins and the guilt of sin, before you.

Is the word edifying you? Are you keeping them? Will you not give all it takes to have a one-on-one relationship with Jesus?



THINK IT OUT


Are you really sure of where you stand? Is your assurance based on popularity and crowd?

This does not also mean that every place people are gathered to worship 'whatever', should be called church.

If Jesus Christ is not the head over all things in there and not the reason for the gathering, then it is not a church.

Jesus said,

“Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord, -- but he who does the will of My Father in heaven” (Matt.7:21).

Then He explained,

“A little while longer and the world will see Me no more, but you will see Me. At that

day you will know that I am in My Father and you in Me, and I in you. He who has my commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him” (John 14:19-21).

The world will not see Jesus', so even if they gather, He is not in them; just as it is written, “Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His” (Rom.8:9).

But those who know Him, love Him, and are led by His Spirit; when they gather, they are called, 'The body of Christ and the Church of God':

“For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God” (Rom. 8:14).

These groups, though not all in the same stages – some are new born; some infant; and some in their maturity stages.

They gather to exhort one another and to worship Christ for the glory of God; here the Spirit of Christ leads, and Christ is the head.

Is Jesus Christ the head of the group you belong to? Are you carrying His presence and are you led by His Spirit?


PRAYER:

Before John the Baptist; though there are examples of Old Testament spiritual baptism,

(1Cor.10:2, 1Peter 3:20) – there was no physical baptism given, which was why the Jews rejected the baptism of John.

When Jesus asked the leaders, and the Pharisee, “The baptism of John – was it from heaven or from men?” (Luke 20:4).

They couldn't answer because they rejected it.

John the Baptist was sent by God to carry out the baptism of repentance and prepare men's hearts for the coming salvation, (John 1:33, Malachi 3:1, 4:5).

Now that Jesus had come and the work of salvation is accomplished, Jesus therefore, told His disciples, “Go therefore and make disciples of all the

nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit” (Matt. 28:19).

Baptism is no longer the baptism of repentance to wash away sins;

Apostle Peter wrote,

“Baptism is not the removal of the filth of the flesh (sin), but the answer of a good conscience toward God” (1Peter 3:21).

It is now a sign of the new covenant in Christ Jesus.

When you accept Jesus, as your Lord and Savior, your sins are forgiven and washed away by the blood He shed at Calvary.

When you agree and go into baptism in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy

Spirit, you are acknowledging and agreeing with His death and resurrection, that you died with Him and resurrect from the dead with Him.

You are actually signing an agreement, or let say, you are agreeing to the sign of the new covenant that you have with God through Christ.

Therefore, Paul said, 'walk in complete newness of life, because you are new.

THINK IT OUT

Do you know that baptism is symbolic,

showing that you died and was raised with Christ and that now you are new?


PRAYER:

important to you?



What part are you playing in the restoration of man? Do you think it is not your business? Have you receive the salvation?



What relationship do you have with Christ if you have not receive His Spirit? Do you know you can receive, if you ask now?



The scripture says

“God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands”
(Act 17:24).

Then, where does He dwells?

Apostle Paul answered by saying,

“Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?
(1 Cor.3:16).

You are the magnificent and beautiful temple, not built by men’s hand but by God Almighty Himself.

And He desires to come in into His temple and dwell there.

Therefore do not deny God His temple, by
disbelieving Him, and by defiling the temple
He built - for you are not your own
(1Cor.6:19).

Be mindful of those things Jesus said, will
defile a man, in Matthew 15:18.
Apostle Paul also mentioned them in
Ephesians 4:30-32.

Know that you are the true magnificent
temple of God, if His Spirit lives in you.

or the one that will be thrown down?


PRAYER:

Do you want to be clean? What are you feeding on? Do you search the scripture as one that searches for a hidden treasure? Do you know that His Spirit is always there to guide?



On what perspective do you operate?


