## **PRAYER:**

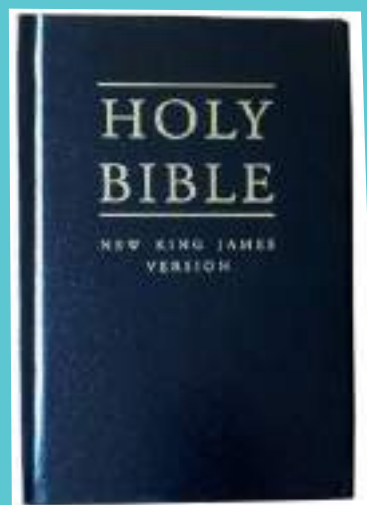
**Dear Lord Jesus thank You, for giving me**
