STAND IN THE TRUE GRACE

Apostle Peter wrote to assure his readers that he, being an eyewitness, testifies that in Jesus is the true grace.

The fact that Jesus said,
“Many will come in My name and will
deceive many”,
and then He also said
“But take heed; see, I have told you all
things beforehand” (Mark 13:6, 23);

means we really need to be watchful and
take heed.

We are told that false prophet and false
apostles will come to deceive;
their coming to deceive here mean, coming
to lead astray from the truth.

Anything that is not true can never yield the
same result as the truth.

Falsehood can never lead to the right
destination.

The very aim of false teachings is Satan's strategy to make sure that people do not get the truth and be saved. (Luke 8:12).

So if you continue to endure or bear with false teachings with the hope that you will still arrive at the same destination in eternity, know that you are doing a dis-service to yourself.

Salvation is personal and not a group thing – so seek the salvation of your soul, and let it come above everything else.

Seek to be sure that you are standing on the true grace of God which is only true Christ Jesus and no other name.

For that reason Jesus said,

“Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it.

Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it” (Matt. 7:13-14).

Make sure you find the gate that leads to life and stand in the true grace; no matter how unpopular it may seem.

Are you really sure of where you stand? Is your assurance based on popularity and crowd?

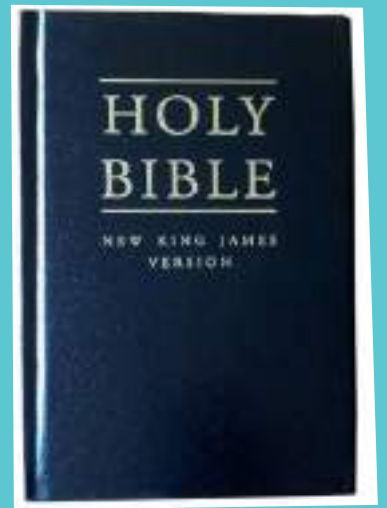
PRAYER:
