HOLD FAST WHAT YOU HAVE

Many, are of the opinion that heaven will just be a hall, where everyone who manages to enter will go in and maybe sit in one of the long benches in the hall.

The wrong perception of what heaven will look like, has made a lot to put less effort in the desire to be worthy of this promise.

But reading the messages of Jesus to the faithful church in Rev. 3, shows there will be a crown; meaning there will be a crowning ceremony; awards and reward ceremonies for those who are deserving.

So Jesus' advice to the church that is called faithful was,

“Hold fast what you have, that no one may

take your crown”.

What is that thing which you have, that is worth keeping?

Apostle Paul said,

“There is laid up for me a crown of righteousness” (2Tim.4:8).

Apostle James talked about a “Crown of life” for those who endured temptation (James 1:12).

Then Apostle Peter talks about the “Crown of glory” for those shepherds who serves as overseers over the flocks of God faithfully, not for dishonest gains and not lording over those that are entrusted to them, but instead serving as an example for the flocks to follow. (1Peter 5:2-4).

These are just three crowns mentioned here, there are many more crowns that people will be crowned with.

Whichever crown you have been able to secure, do not let anyone take that crown from you
