What better place could you ask for? Are you, in conduct and lifestyles waiting for this new city? Where will you spend your eternity?

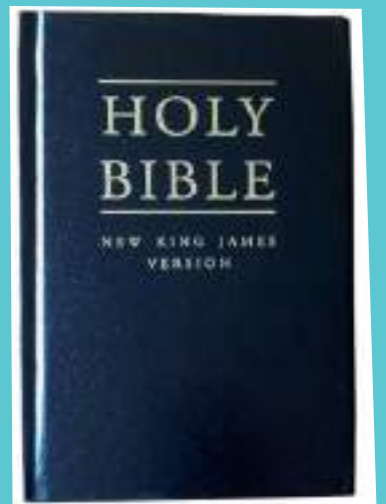
PRAYER:
