**THAT DAY YOU
WILL KNOW**

Jesus said to His disciples,

“At that day you will know that I am in My
Father, and you in Me, and I in you”.

The disciples already knew Jesus because He was walking with them, but He told them that a day is coming, which they will know that He is in the Father, and they will be in Him as He will be in them.

What day was He talking about?

And what kind of relationship was He talking about?

First, that day will be the day they receive the indwelling Holy Spirit, whom He promised the Father will send in John 14:16.

The Holy Spirit, will teach them the relationship Jesus had with the Father, when He said,

“Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works”.

That indwelling presence of God the Father in Christ Jesus as He walked this earth, is what Jesus said His disciples will know in the day they receive the Holy Spirit, because they themselves will experience the same relationship and oneness with Him.

It is obvious that this is the relationship Jesus wants to have with everyone who believes in Him; because everyone who believes and accept Him as Lord and Savior, is His disciple.

The Scriptures say,

“But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God”

(John 1:12);

So Apostle Paul wrote,

“Having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise” (Eph.1:13).

Also Apostle John said,

“By this we know that we abide in Him, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit” (1John 4:13).

If you have received His Spirit, you will know and experience the relationship of oneness He came to give to man.

Is He dwelling in you? Do you know you only need to believe and ask?


PRAYER:
