Paul said,

'God separated me from my mother's womb'.

When we go astray forsaking His love, His ways and His mercies – yet His grace is always available and sufficient for everyone who turn to Him for mercy.

God has never forsaken us in spite of our waywardness; Jesus gave the parable of the lost son in Luke 15:11-24, to illustrate the mercies and steadfast love of our heavenly Father towards us His children – Note, no one is excluded here; you can become a child anytime you choose.

Salvation was paid for at the cross, where

We do not need to remain in the place of dis-union with our heavenly Father, because He through His grace had already extended forgiveness toward us, through the death of His only begotten Son Jesus Christ (Rom.5:8);

receive His mercy and come home.

You can come to Him just as you are; but be sincere and be open hearted, and He who knew you from the womb and also knows your end, will take you just the way you are and make you into what He want you to be. The grace is still available.

Do you know there is a Father who loves you dearly more than anyone would ever love you? Will you come with a sincere heart?


PRAYER:
